CURRENT ITEMS.

"FAIR weather" Christians were conspicuous by their absence at all the protestant churches last Sunday evening.

We understand that a son of President Zelaya shot himself in Nicaragua some two weeks since in consequence of some love affair.

"El Noticiero" says that the president of Honduras, who is at present in this port, will shortly leave for Europe, where he intends making his future home.

In a mountain in the neighborhood of Escasu a young native of that place claims to have discovered coal, which many people think to be of an exceedingly good quality. "El Noticiero."

Mr. Herbert Palfrey, of the firm of Palfrey and Dameron, New Orleans, arrived here a few days ago on business connected with his firm. He is accompanied by his daughter, Miss Gertrude Palfrey.

"THE Schooner 'Union C'" (Captain William Taylor) left here for Bocas del Toro on Saturday afternoon last; from there she will proceed to Colon and from Colon to Bluefields the quarantine restrictions prohibiting her return here. Captain Taylor proposes making regular trips between Bluefields and Colon, taking in Limon and Bocas on her southern trip. The port charges, however, are so considerable that it is questionable if the business will prove a profitable one. The passenger fares are reasonable enough, that from Limon to Bocas being C8. Whenever possible, Captain Taylor will advise this office by telegraph the probable date of his arrival here, so that passengers may be prepared by the time the schooner arrives.

COSTA RICA.

FROM OUR CORRESPONDENT.

The 340 feet extension of the C. R. Railway pier is progressing favorably under the able management of Mr. G. W. Rothery, late Master Mechanic of the Company, a distance of thirty feet has already been added to the existing pier, the direction has been slightly changed towards the centre of Quarantine Island, had the original plans been carried out which were in a N. E. direction, it would have been almost an impossibility for the U. F. Co.'s Steamers to berth at their dock, even with present deviation it will require careful handling of a Steamer to reach the No 1 berth.

It is expected that the first steamer will go alongside the U. F. Co's pier in the course of a fortnight. This new pier will be under the control of Capt. Simmons (late of the B. I. Co. of Colon.) No better choice could have been made, as Capt. Simmons is an ideal Wharf master (in addition to his being Government pilot) his able handling of two hundred labourers employed in loading the fruit Steamers of the Company during the past three years has proved—Colon Telegram.
