Guatemala is Purchased by Syndicate

ENTIRE RESOURCES OF REPUBLIC BOUGHT; DEAL ONLY LACKS APPROVAL OF PEOPLE.

GERMANS ARE INDIGNANT.

Cover King Clark at Head of Combine Which Buys a Country Outright.

After a struggle that has been going on for three years, during which German opposition and local prejudice have had to be fought constantly, the right to develop the vast mineral wealth of Guatemala has at last been secured by a group of American capitalists. At the head of this commission are former Governor A. E. Springs of Motano, former Senator W. A. Clark of the State and a number of capitalists closely identified with the Guggenheim interests. French capital is also invested in the deal.

The terms of the concession, which has been signed by President Don Manuel Estrada Cabrera, are of the broadest character. They turn the Central American republic over to this syndicate. Not only are all public lands in Guatemala turned over to the Americans for exploration and development but the right also is given them to build railroads and bridges where they see fit, to use the great waterways of the republic for their own purposes, to build and operate telegraph and telephone lines; in fact to do about as they please.

AWAIST ASSEMBLY'S O. K.

Just one little formality remains to be arranged before the Americans, who are operating under the title of the Guatemala Mining and Development Company, can exercise the privileges that President Cabrera has signed over to them. The form of the concession must be approved by the Guatemalan national assembly.

The assembly is now in session, but the concession has not yet been presented to it. The New Yorkers interested in the enterprise, among whom is Congressman William Sulzer, say the matter will be closed next week, but there are already rumours of an opposition based on the claim that President Cabrera and his cabinet have practically sold everything in the republic worth having to the Americans and have not received an adequate price in return. Behind this opposition are the German concessionaires in the republic.

GUATEMALA GETS 10 PER CENT.

The terms made by the syndicate with Cabrera are that ten per cent of the net profits of any enterprise the Americans start shall be paid into the treasury of the republic. The opposition insists that if the convention is to be ratified by the national assembly one of the terms shall be:

"All controversies and difficulties shall be submitted for final settlement to the President of the United States of America, whose ruling will be final and executive."

The syndicate, according to re-

port does not want to include these terms in the contract.

Among financiers the deal that the Spriggs-Clark-Guggenheim syndicate has practically brought to a successful conclusion is regarded as one of the biggest things that has ever been accomplished by a group of American capitalists. As one man put it today: "It is the first time in the history of the continent that a country has been bought outright, just as a house wife would buy a spool of thread."

It was also pointed out today that the American invasion of the Central American republic is of great strategic importance to the United States and that the syndicate has the backing of the Taft administration. The government influence behind the capitalists, however, cannot, of course, openly manifest itself.

RESULTS OF SECOND FIXTURE IN ALL-JAMAICA VS. M. C. C. TEAM.

Visitors Score Well in Their Second Innings.

The second match between All Jamaica and the M. C. C., ended in a draw at Sabina Park, to all appearances in favour of the visiting team.

The result of this match was not surprising, and was in accord with the prognostications of many followers of the grand old game; for before the game was started the general opinion was that it could not be concluded in the time agreed upon.

Nevertheless, before the luncheon hour it looked as if Jamaica would not only gain a hollow victory, but that the match would be concluded before the call of time. If they were to win they would have to score at a fairly fast rate. They had a spartan chance of achieving a victory, and trying to score at a rapid rate, they had lost fully eight wickets for just a little over a hundred runs.
