## Controversy Is Settled.

In view of the long controversy going on between the Jamaica District of the order of Good Samaritans and the Panama District of the same order for Supremacy in Panama and Central America. We publish the following Order, from the Executive body of the order in America which seem to decide the matter once for all—

### PROCLAMATION

Office of the National Grand Sire National Grand Lodge—

I. O. of G. S. & D. of N. America & West Indies  
1518 N. Clarion St  
Phil. Pa., Nov. 16 1912.

In accordance with resolutions adopted at the last Annual Session of the National Grand Lodge, held at Jacksonville, Fla. Aug. 27, 28, 29 and 30, 1912, the Charters of District Grand Lodge, No. 7 of Central America and Panama and of Western District Grand Lodge No. 20, of Jamaica were recalled. A Committee was appointed by the National Grand Lodge to meet in conjunction with the Trustee Board of the N. G. L. to adjust the Territory of the Two Grand Lodges. This being the cause of the long controversy between them. The committee met in Philadelphia on the above date at the office of the R. W. N. G. Sire, Bro. C. L. Thomas, D. G. L. No. 7, of Central America responded to the call of the N. G. Lodge, and its charter was in the hands of the N. G. Sec'y in due time. W. D. G. L. No. 20 refused to send its charter, and send affidavits which were not received by the committee.

The question of Territory was discussed D. G. Lodge No. 7 was given the territory of Central America. W. D. G. Lodge No. 20 will stand suspended until the edicts of the R. W. N. G. Lodge are obeyed and the Committee on Adjudication pass on its territorial rights.

All Subordinate Lodges in Panama, Trinidad, Jamaica and other adjacent Republics desiring to be loyal to the mandates of the R. W. N. G. Lodge must come under immediate jurisdiction of the said body until adjusted.

We have affixed our signature and caused the seal of the National Grand Lodge to be attached this 30th day of November, 1912.



In a small place as Limon one can hardly lift his hat to a lady that it is not heard of next day and to think that our police force filled with probably the best detectives to be found in the country know nothing of these pits, where this hideous crime is carried on ad lib. Limon has never been so infested with the class of lewd women as we have today, which gives a sad spectacle and a poor example to our rising girls we have them in the very centre of the town, and why, because the government grants licenses for assisting in the perpetration of this evil life and seem to wink at the committal of the offense.

## Men for Bananito.

We notice men running around town catching up labourers for Bananito construction.

The Editor of this Journal is in the sad position of being held by the Managers of the U. F. Coy. as being responsible for the cause that men are unwilling to go to Bananito to work; but if these men come and complain that the wages are unremunerative and conditions unsuitable for work, and that without Police protection they are liable to be robbed one way or another; what can one do, but state the information. Labourers are not advised against going to work at Bananito, but to the contrary it has also been stated in these columns that the construction at Bananito is the Salvation of our workmen, but if these very workmen complain that they cannot make wages there, why should the unfortunate Editor of the Times be condemned by the Superintendent as the cause of labourers refusing to go there to work.


