

No hope for Peace. A Shark's dinner.

London, Feb. 2.—Inasmuch as every thing is being done in diplomatic circles to avoid a renewal of the war, it is admitted frankly that the probabilities are very meagre. The Armistice expires at 7 p.m. to-day. According to advices from the Allies, the Kaiser made a Supreme effort at the last moment to preserve peace. The correspondent of the "Daily Express" in Berlin says that His Majesty gave instructions to the German Minister at St. Petersburg to use all efforts at hand to get King Fernando to accept the Turkish propositions.

Washington, Feb. 2.—The Senate approved by a vote of 47 against 33 that the term of office of the future President shall be 6 years instead of 4, it is not expected that the Upper House will approve it, anyway if it does, it must also be ratified by the 36 States. Mayor Wiley excongressman opposes the Bill for independence of the Philippines, on the ground that they cannot yet govern themselves.

When a 12ft. 6in. shark caught in Mauritius, was cut open, a dog, a goat and a large collection of bones of animals were found inside.

The shark was caught with a line from a 20ft. open boat, and was hauled to the surface after a desperate struggle says a writer in the "Field."

During the fight the scene had been exciting. The boat rolling, the men pulling and hauling for all they were worth the shark plunging wildly in all directions, my boat shouting advice and encouragement, and I doing my best in all this turmoil to keep cool and shoot straight. Four bullets were required to kill the shark— "Gleaner"

Johnson's Troubles.

Chicago, Ill., Jan. 15.—Jack Johnson, the pugilist, was vindicated by Judge Carpenter in the United States District Court today, of the charge that he was fleeing the country to escape trial as a "white" slaver and smuggler when he was intercepted Tuesday morning in Battle Creek, Mich.

"The fighter was brought into court after a night in the county jail. He protested that he merely was going to Toronto to confer with his manager.

John Morris, a surety on the \$5,000 bond of Johnson in the smuggling case, asked that he be permitted to surrender the pugilist. The jurist ordered Johnson to furnish a new bond within two days.

Judge Carpenter warned Johnson that he should not leave the jurisdiction of the court again and that if he did, his bond in the white slave case would be forfeited.

New Arrangement

Montreal, Jan. 25.—Atlantic Fruit distributors of New York, of which Mr. Joseph DiGiorgio is President, will, through its operating subsidiaries, handle the entire shipping output of the California fruit distributors. This latter concern carries among many others the business of the Earl Fruit Company, largest deciduous fruit organization in California, the aggregate volume of which was more than 9,000 cars in 1912, and which, with a normally fair season is expected to exceed 10,000 cars in 1913.

Under the new arrangement the Atlantic Fruit distributors will be the selling agents of both the deciduous business and the banana business now conducted on such a large scale by the Atlantic Fruit Company. The parent concern, which is the Atlantic Fruit Coy., under the management of Mr. DiGiorgio, will handle the banana business of the organization of 1913, and this will be in excess of 9,000,000 bunches.

Lost on Titanic.

Rome, Jan. 16.—The Bank of Italy believes that the lottery ticket first prize of 1,000,000 francs was lost on the Titanic last April with a batch of other tickets which were sent to the U. S. on that vessel. All efforts to trace the holder of the ticket have been fruitless.

It has been reported that the winning ticket was sold in Sicily, but the bank has so far found no one to whom the claim should be paid.

The Banana.

The "Gleaner" of a recent date, publishes the following: Many things have been said of the banana. It has been left to a firm of Liverpool dried fruit dealers to term Jamaica's premier product 'aggressive.' It seems to have earned this adjective by reason of its successful competition with Valencia raisins and Zuckey figs. Popular taste for the latter fruits would seem to be declining, and their disappearance into the background is laid to the charge of the banana. Certainly the Banana maintains a footing which would rejoice the heart of Sir Alfred Jones, were he still with us. Displays in every fruiterer's windows and laden barrows trundled along every City street are standing advertisements of the demand for the golden fruit.—W. L. Committee Circular.

Cables

Washington, Feb. 2.—Scherin, Vice President of Pacific Mail and Steamship Coy. declared in the investigation of the Navigation Trust: "We navigate in disastrous conditions. The Subsidy given to the Japanese Coys. seriously impedes our earnings and with the passage of the Canal it will render as impossible to complete. It is best to withdraw our boats. He attacked severely the Wilson Law which prohibits the Chinese Crew on our boats which is the very best for the Pacific service.

The new Minister of Marine has issued an order making it compulsory to study Spanish for four years in the Naval Academy.

Chicago, 2.—It is shown that the earnings of the four great packing Coys. are equal to the receipts of the 4 largest Rail road Companies. The total income of Swift & Coy. was 300 millions, Armour & Coy. 285 millions, Morris & Coy. 99 millions.

The percentage of dividends on the shares is far superior to past years. The spring exceptionally fine brought in a crop of grains never yet known, the condition of the cattle and the facilities for fattening stock has enhanced the income inasmuch as the quantity of cattle has decreased on account of excessive butchering in past years, the cattle are fattened on corn at 35 cents per bushel, against 70 in the past year.

The price of cattle is 8.90 per quintal against 11.10 in Dec. last year. The farmers take opportunity of the low price of corn to fatten a considerable quantity of pigs. The elevators are incapable to receive all the corn sent in on deposits. The cables from Argentines confirm the news of the destruction of the corn crop by long drought.

Paris 1.—The banks refuse to pay out gold in consequence of the scarcity of gold they pay in paper, twenty per cent is given for every hundred dollars gold.

Berlin 1.—The Empress will go to the mountain baths, to re-establish her health which has been failing rapidly during the past year.

New York 30.—It is said that a loan has been arranged in America by Siria for the construction of a railroad as soon as hostilities are completed.

Viscount Kitchener

A proposal has been made that the medal of the war of 1870 shall be accorded to Field Marshall Viscount Kitchener. It is pointed out that he has the fullest right to the decoration. When the war broke out, he was 20 years of age, and was living at Dinan with his mother. He volunteered at once and joined a flying squadron of the Cotes-du-Nord, with which he saw strenuous service under General Jaures. As a result of privations endured in the campaign he contracted a severe attack of pneumonia, which for a time endangered his life. There is little doubt that the suggestion will meet with warm welcome throughout France.—"Gleaner"

Improvements.

One can hardly believe that the swamps and tiger haunts of a few years ago, at Jamaica Town could today be decked with Electric lights, yet it is so. Due to the push and enterprise of the Electric Light and Power Coy., of Port Limon, as well as the energy of the residents of that place, an arc light has been erected at the corner of the second street in front of the Concordia Lodge, Mr. Lazarus and Mr. Brady's house. This is a great boon to the public, and the U. F. Coy. have to be complimented very much for their consideration in this respect. It is true one may argue that they are paid for it, yet if they cared to be disabling, a thousand and one excuses could have been made for the inconveniences of locating a light there. The members of the Lodge there ought particularly to be grateful for this favour granted them, as the darkness of those regions was a great deterrent to the prompt attendance of the members.

Vessel lost With 29 lives

News has been received by wireless from Bluefields, that launch Granada has foundered in the Colorado Bar, with 29 lives. There were 30 souls on board with passengers and crew bound for Port Limon and Bocas del Toro, and all went down only one life being saved.

Squirres Races

We have before us the programme of the Squirres Races to come off on 24th and 25th of March; but again the programme seem very much at fault. In the first instance our experience here in racing native bred horses proves that we have not seen any 15 hands horses competing, yet the programme has 3 races out of 9 for 15 hand horses, one for 14½ and one for 14¾ hand horses; it is well known that Silverwing, Grafton, and Ballwood are the only three horses to be classed as 14½ hands and none of 14¾ and from what can be gathered neither Silverwing nor Grafton will face the flag again. Meantime, Lady Clara, Vagamundo, Oscar Wilde, Sparrow and Alma, are all of the class of 14 hands and under, why then should the 15 hands races not be struck out and made for 14 hand horses. With this change we think the programme will be a success because all the sports in our vicinity seem to be between the 13, 13½, 14 and 14½ hands horses. We hope the Committee will find it convenient to make this little change. The 14¾ race seem to be a mistake as we suspect this to be for 13½, but the 14 hands and under, would cover all that.

Great Fire.

Savannah, Georgia, Feb. 2.—In consequence of an explosion a fire broke out which destroyed ¼ mile of houses. The destruction of the Electric Coy. of Savannah is feared, the losses are calculated at one billion.

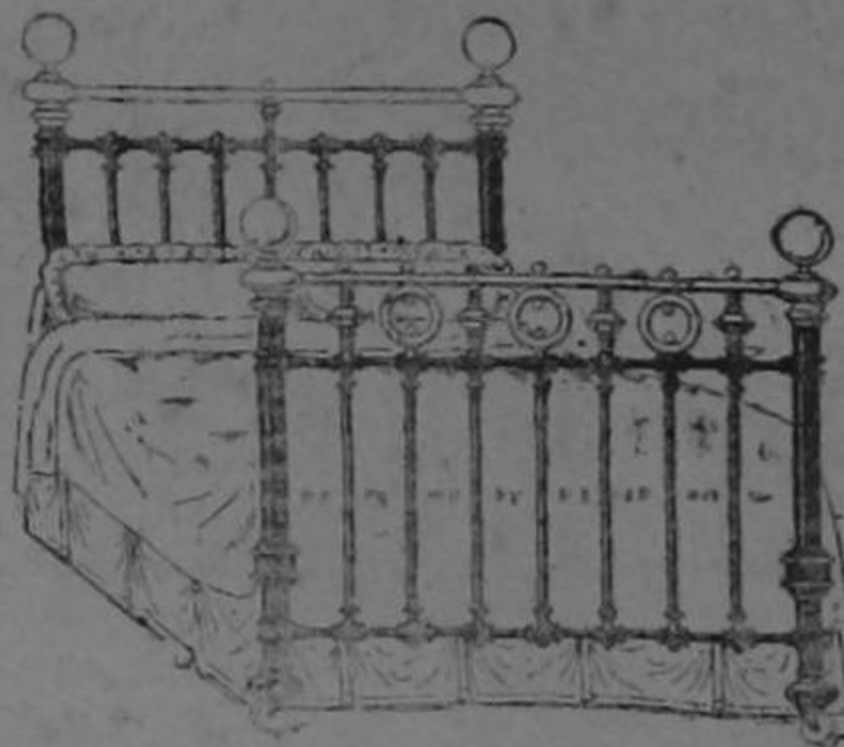
