

MORAL LAW

The developement of great powers frequently is followed by decay. Such is the situa. tion rapidly developing in Europe today. Having attained a great deal of physical and finincial power, European rulers do not feel the necessity of abiding by the principles and laws on which power is found-

The moral law is to a race or nation what the root is to a tree. As long as the root is deeply set in the ground and is in a healty condition, the tree is prepared to bear any storm; if the above conditions are changed, the tree can no longer withstand the violence of the storm. In like manner as long as a race or nation con tinues to live according to moral laws and principles its changes or survival are good, other conditions being normal,

We see in Europe today a complete break-down of the moral law. The relations of one European nation with another, or with a non-European nation, are no longer subject to moral laws and principles. There is a complete disregard for the rights of others. Promises are broken, verbal agree ments are forgotten, treaties are scraps of paper, international laws are violated.

In Europe today, there is mutual distrust and hatred, in the rest of the world there is resentment against the white race. Black people have long been oppressed and belittled. Let us mark carefully and im press upon our people the con-

No Democracy which believes in the right of both large and small nationate govern themselves, could tolerate such aims. And so America and Britain have raken up arms against the Far Eastern partner in the bloody Axis and with grim determination and the confidence of a united people, will fight to final victory.

It was the resources of America that were bringing the freedom-loving powers' production up to mark with Germany's, and finally outsripping Hitler in the long rou. Now, however, America will have to divert her production into supplying her own armies and even if there is a residue, it will heex tremely difficult to transport it across the Facific to the Middle East,

Japan's action cannot conceivably result in anything but her eventual destruction. Granted that she succeeds in capturing the American and British bases. This mere can and British bases. This mere withdraws temperary to the shores, renews her strength and continues the assault. For remember, Japan cannot hope to invade the U.S. and conquer her.

This cannot be a pleasant prospect for Japan. She attempted to conquer Caina and the result is a long drawn out stalemate. A second stalemate with a first class mi litary power like the United States can only result in her internal collasse.

Japan as therefore launched a war which she cannot hope to win, despite her temporary victo ries.
