No Land Too Hot or Too Cold For Man.

90 DEGREES BELOW ZERO IN SIBERIA. 124 ABOVE IN ALGERIA, THE AUTHENTICATED EXTREMES.

Plants and animals cannot exist in temperatures far higher and lower than those to which they have become accustomed while man moves from one extreme to the other, with, for the most part, but little physical discomfort. Explorers will visit the sands of Africa and the bleakness of the Arctic Circle and return to normal environments even improved in physical condition.

Man inhabits about every part of the earth except a few island regions in the interior of continents and immediate vicinity of the poles. It is from dread of climatic conditions that his tent has found no more than a temporary resting place in some of these far distant spots. It is not thought that the heat or cold of any of the unexplored regions of the globe has a greater range of temperature than many regions now inhabited.

Science reasons that the lowest temperatures at the earth's surface are not found directly at the poles but at some distance to the south of the north pole and to the north of the south pole. Likewise the greatest degree of heat is not, as might be supposed, to be found at the equator, but prevails at some distance to the north and to the south of that imaginary line.

The coldest place on the earth's surface of which there is authentic record is in Siberia. The lowest temperature ever recorded in the open air was 90 degrees below zero (Fahrenheit) at Wercchajansk, central Siberia, on January 15, 1885.

The highest temperature of which there is an authenticated record is 124 deg. above zero (Fahrenheit) in Algeria, northern Africa, on July 17, 1870. These places of extreme heat and extreme cold give a range of temperature covering the whole inhabitable world of 214 degrees, or two degrees more than from zero to the boiling point.

In the United States the lowest temperature ever recorded in winter is 64 degrees below zero in North Dakota, and the highest ever recorded in summer is 115 degrees above zero in Arizona. This gives a total range of 179 degrees within about 1,000 miles.

There is an authenticated report from Aunale, an outpost of the Algerian bad lands, which gives a temperature record in the open air of 172 degrees above zero (Fahrenheit). This if correct exceeds by 48 degrees that of the highest on record. It is also stated that the temperature at this place rarely gets down to 140 degrees. On one or two occasions it dropped to 120 degrees and the natives shivered with the cold. Strange as it may seem, the death rate of French soldiers stationed at this post is lower than that at more northerly places having equal temperatures.

People who inhabit these places of extreme heat and cold are found to be exceptionally

healthy and live to a ripe old age. While men in all parts of the world make their homes in these exceptionally hot or cold places and move from one to the other without any apparent physical discomfort, it is found that animals or plants which would flourish in one could not survive in the other.

In the United States the extreme range of heat is not so great but one may live in comparative comfort in any section; yet the same conditions apply to animal and plant life as prevail throughout the rest of the world; animals and plants that survive the winters of the south could not endure the winters of the north.

The greatest of the extremes of heat and cold in this country are found in the Western States, from the Dakotas and Montana southward to Texas and Arizona. The temperature in the Northwest during the winter months frequently drops to 30 or 40 degrees below zero and occasionally runs below 60 degrees, while the heat of summer in the central West and Southwest touches 100 degrees or higher. Regardless of such extremes the climatic conditions throughout the entire Rocky Mountain range are delightful for ten months of the year.

The most equable temperature throughout the year in the United States is found along the seacoast. Nearly two-thirds of the entire population lives in seacoast cities. People may complain of a few blustery and unusually cold days in winter and of a few sweltering hot and humid days in summer, but with all things considered the climate of the entire Atlantic seaboard is liberal in her food products and the fertility of the soil seems inexhaustible.

The effect of the recent heavy rains on the lines would seem to make slides at a hundred places with the most gossal at Torito and Los Lunas.

Celestial Tramp.

ASTRONOMERS ARE GREATLY INTERESTED IN A NEW COMET.

Chicago.—Nightly observations of the latest "celestial tramp," known as "Kiss comet," are being taken at the Yerkes Observatory by Prof. Edwin B. Frost and Prof. Scherzer W. Brumbaugh. The new comet was first picked up by the observers at Williams Bay on July 8, the day following the departure of the Lick Observatory astronomer in his discovery.

"I doubt whether it will be visible to the naked eye," said Prof. Frost. "We will not be able to tell for several days. It is not a particularly brilliant comet. It rises in the east between 1 and 1.30 a.m.

Current Items.

Twenty railroad cars were landed from the "Cartago" yesterday for the Pacific Railroad Company.

Freezing the Hair On.

It is reported that Ernest Shackleton, the famous explorer, uses one of the best means of strengthening his hair. Japanese Census on European Lines.

The Japanese are going to take their next census according to European methods, Japanese professor from the University of Tokyo in Japan sent a view to study the taking of the Italian census. He knows Italian as perfectly as a native. He has already been in Berlin and Vienna with a similar object. The Japanese census is to be taken on more exact lines than has ever been attempted on previous occasions.

Atlanta has a Jack the Ripper.

Atlanta.—Apparently a Jack the Ripper is at work in Atlanta, and his purpose is to murder negro women.

The killing of the mutilated body of a comedy negro in a side street marks the sixth of a series of murders which have puzzled detectives and thrown the negro population into a state of terror.

Each of six consecutive Sunday nights has seen the murder of a negro and in each instance the body has been mutilated in such a manner as to indicate that the same person committed the crime.

The victims have all been young and the indications are that they were first strangled and then mutilated in a manner to indicate exact knowledge of anatomy.

In each instance the body of the victim has been found in a lonely side street. Physicians say the murderer is undoubtedly a pervert with knowledge of anatomy. The detectives have no clue. The negroes are so terrified that they are keeping off the streets at night.


