PARIS, 2. — Los periódicos franceses al comentar el desarrollo de los acontecimientos surgidos por la actitud del jefe del gobierno alemán, Adolfo Hitler, califican de engañosa la proposición de paz presentada por Hitler por cuanto tiende a aislar a Francia de sus aliados para convertir a Hitler en dictador de Europa.

LONDRES, 2. — El gobierno británico después de su sesión de gabinete, comunicó a Francia y a Bélgica, que de acuerdo con el Pacto de Locarno, vigente, Inglaterra les prestará su apoyo, aunque fracasaren las negociaciones de arreglo con Alemania.

En octubre: de caridad, 15; por cuenta de particulares, 6; por cuenta de Compañía bananera, 1; por cuenta del gobierno, ninguna; en total, 22 inhumaciones.

En noviembre: de caridad, 14; por cuenta de particulares, 7; por cuenta de Compañía bananera, 12; por cuenta del gobierno, 2; en total, 35 inhumaciones.

En diciembre: de caridad, 14; por cuenta de particulares, 5; por cuenta de Compañía bananera, 7; por cuenta del gobierno, ninguna; en total, 26 inhumaciones.

Durante el trimestre: de caridad, 43; por cuenta de particulares, 18; por cuenta de Compañía bananera, 20; por cuenta del gobierno, 2; lo que da un total en el trimestre de 83 inhumaciones.

NOTAS EDITORIALES

En el lote uno de la manzana 19 se están construyendo, por cuenta de la Secretaría de Hacienda, tres casas de habitación para algunos empleados de la Aduana. El propósito es bueno y las casas magníficas. El costo de ellas no bajaría de cien mil colones, tal como están los precios del material de construcción. Pero en las mismas dependencias de la Secretaría de Hacienda, en la propia Aduana de Limón, nos dice persona que nos merece entero crédito, hay guardas que trabajan diez y ocho horas diarias por falta de personal suficiente.

Si la versión es cierta, hay en estos contrastes una enorme injusticia que debe corregirse. Si el personal del Resguardo no es suficiente para prestar un buen servicio, sin agotar a los empleados por un exceso de trabajo, el presupuesto debe ampliarse. Si este presupuesto no alcanza para sostener el número de empleados que el servicio requiere, no se explica como puede destinarse una suma tan fuerte para otras necesidades menos urgentes y menos justas. No es que nosotros critiquemos que se construyan casas para mejorar la vida de empleados que ganan poco sueldo. Lo que nos parece es que antes que las casas la Secretaría de Hacienda está obligada a organizar los servicios con una base de justicia y de equidad.

Un empleado no puede trabajar diez y ocho horas a día, no solamente porque la ley lo prohíbe, si las leyes significaran algo entre nosotros. Es que la justicia que ha de estar por encima de las leyes, pugna con la injusticia que anotamos. Por otra parte, un empleado a quien se recarga el trabajo en esta forma agotadora, no puede hacer una labor eficiente. El sueldo tampoco está en proporción con el trabajo.

Sabemos que el señor Administrador de Aduana ha tratado de conseguir la ampliación de estas plazas, pero sin resultado ninguno porque ante la eterna fórmula de la falta de presupuesto, tropieza siempre toda mejora que se intente en los servicios oficiales.

Si el señor presidente electo, licenciado Cortés, al organizar los servicios administrativos—que habrá que organizarlos todos—tomara nota de estas observaciones, hechas sin empeño de crítica, sino en un deseo, completamente desinteresado, de mejorar servicios y suprimir injusticias, haría una verdadera labor de mejoramiento.

Al actual Secretario de Hacienda no nos atrevemos a distraerlo con estas naderías. No está bien interrumpir su rotaria labor de estudios económicos, reclinado como está, con sus otros compañeros de gabinete, en el santo seno de Abraham.

Pecando de indiscretos, vamos a dar a nuestros lectores una información sensacional: hemos podido enterarnos de que numerosos mencionados se reunió en un


de unirse para hacer una especie de huelga no pagando los impuestos de pavimentación. Recordarán los limonenses que hace más de un año la cuota de pavimentación

W. WILSON
Ex-Presidente de los EE. UU.

Hace diez y nueve años, cuando la guerra europea, había alcanzado los caracteres más culminantes, el Presidente de los Estados Unidos de aquel entonces, Woodrow Wilson, considerando que ciertos hechos realizados por Agentes del Gobierno alemán, pugnaban con el respeto debido entre naciones amigas, en un vibrante discurso pronunciado ante el Senado y el Congreso americano, pidió que estos decretaran la declaratoria de guerra de los Estados Unidos a Alemania; declarando entre otras cosas: "No somos sino uno de los campeones de los derechos de la humanidad.—Vamos a la guerra sencillamente porque hemos sido forzados a ello y porque no hay otros medios para mantener nuestros derechos, nos será mucho más fácil tornarnos beligerantes porque nosotros actuamos sin animosidad, no como enemigos de un pueblo ni por el deseo de perjudicarlo, sino únicamente como una oposición armada contra un Gobierno irresponsable que ha arrojado a un lado todas las consideraciones que se deben a los derechos de la humanidad y que nos ataca a ciegas".

A lo que el Senado y el Congreso, resolvieron favorablemente, aprobando la actitud del Presidente Wilson y autorizándolo para ejercer todos los poderes y emplear todos los recursos para hacer la guerra y llevar el conflicto a un fin victorioso.

Important Case of Libel

A case of Libel against Mr. Manuel Francisco Jimenez has been placed before the Supreme Court by Mr. Mariano Guardia. The hearing has been fixed for the 15th instant and due to the personality of these two eminent lawyers, considerable interest is being focused on the suit.

In view of the freedom generally admitted the Press and the technicality or the arguments which will be advanced by such two Jurists, a case of the kind is worth travelling many miles to witness.

Our Likely Official Changes

Since the appearance of the item in the Spanish section of our last issue, we learn from a very reliable source that although our highly esteemed don Abel Robles will be one of our new officials as a result of the recent election, and will occupy an important position, it will neither be as Captain of the Post nor as Governor. In so far as our knowledge goes at this time, the occupant of the latter position will, in all probability, be a member of one of our City's oldest and most respected families don Ricardo Alvarado.

Great Opportunities Looming

Recently we have seen many propositions for commercial tradings with this country enunciated by merchants of the United States as well as by those of Canada. This latter country has offered us a market for all the mahogany and other valuable lumber we can supply: while there is a great demand and much promise of a brisk trade in the Tunny Fish business on the Puntarenas end with the former.

Our capitalists are at last realizing the grand possibility of producing wheat and cotton as favourably as in the United States; and we now observe that an importante American Firm desires to take all the fruit, vegetable and yuca that can be offered them. The Secretary of Agriculture, through whom the enquiry was made, has turned the proposition over to the Department of Agriculture, fostered by the International Bank, to obtain the necessary statistics as to the quantum which might be available in the line of fruit, such as Pineapples, Papayas, Mangoes, Cashew, Citrus fruit, Breadfruit, Plums, Sour and Sweet Sops, Anonas or Naseberries, Avocado Pears Custard Apples, etc. Undoubtedly large crops of these could be obtained and made marketable, especially among the smaller settlers with their little holdings; the lack of financial assistance is, however, always the deterrent to any proposition which may be thrown our way.

We have always contended and argued that the government should institute Agricultural Loan Banks in every Province to assist bona fide agriculturists, large or small, and here is the chance for our authorities to do something in this direction to promote a thriving peasant population. By instituting small holdings, under the control of Citizens Associations, throughout the country, available to every citizen who has lived here for at least seven years, and making advances, on the

recommendations of an Agricultural Board of the Canton, for the proper cultivation of these holdings with such things as are needed for exportation, such a plan would make a wonderful change in the habits and customs of our communities and promote true happiness and contentment among our people.

Within another four or five weeks we shall be having a change of government, and as don Leon Cortes is known to be a man full of energy and progressive ideas, we are believing that such matters as the proper development of his country will receive his early and serious consideration.

It is said he is against Communism and is therefore determined to stamp it out of the country; and as it is an acknowledged fact that Communism can never find a place in any country which possesses a thriving, contented population, we sincerely hope don Leon's chief aim will be to see that his communities are made prosperous by affording them assistance to cultivate not only for their own needs but to supply the requests of the world's markets. If he could succeed in having this done he would be dealing Communism its death blow without violence.

Of course indiscreet, dishonest dolings out of the Funds of the State, as has been the experience of some of our Banks in the near past, must be safeguarded by the rigid punishment of any offender whether such be the King's son or the son of the slave. All acts of bribery or corruption with respect to recommendations for financial assistance to cultivators as also failure to cultivate or otherwise fulfil the terms under which the aid is given must be made punishable by Law irrespective of whose cousin the offending party might be. Then and only then shall we find our small settlers and peasants receiving their just and proper consideration from the general body of our State Officials. The overburdening of the State's Treasury, resulting in overcharged appropriations to favoured ones would also be a thing of the past and in place of deficits in Revenue to cover padded governmental appropriations year after year, there would result increased revenue and smaller appropriations.

Britain watches Ethiopia's Lake Tana

A million acres are waiting in the Sudan to be planted to cotton as soon as the water can be had without encroaching on Egypt's supply. Egypt too has discovered the money that lies in cotton; but the rhythm of its agriculture has to be timed to the immense seasonal variations in its water supply. There are also occasional "lean years", just as there were in biblical times. A "good Nile" is a rise of about twenty-

volume of water available at any reservoir in the world. The result would be an in calculable benefit for the whole valley of the Nile. The Sudan would get the extra water it needs for more cotton. The present seasonal variations in the river's flow, both in the Sudan and in Egypt, could be leveled off, and in the years of a "bad Nile" there would be an ample reserve of water.

As an engineering project it looks perfect. There is much to be said for the view that the whole 4,000-mile basin of the Nile constitutes a single problem in hydraulic engineering. But the more the engineers insist on viewing it in that light, the more

the politicians seem to view it as a series of sometimes discordant political problems. Down in the Sudan and

Egypt the engineers have so far managed to get their way, but in Ethiopia their writ does not yet run. Lake

Tana is still in the hands of the politicians, and the engineers can only wait.

five feet at Assuan, but there are years when the rise is only twenty feet and there is no present reserve which is capable of making up the deficiency.

The inevitable sequel to the immense conservation projects at Assuan, at Gebel Aulia on the White Nile and at the Sennar dam on the Blue Nile is — as the engineer sees it — control of the flood at Lake Tana. The blueprints have been ready for years. The chief difficulty would be that of getting the machinery and building material up to the lake, which is six days by mule from the nearest point on the Sudan frontier.

By supplementing the existing natural dam with a great barrage, equipped with sluices ten feet lower than the present riverchannels, they could tap a ten-foot depth of water over the whole area of the lake, about 1,100 square miles — by far the largest

The Barclay administration has promised a school in every "luge" for freed American slave village, no matter how small, and new opportunities for citizens to sell the products of the country.

Three-Year Program Starts
Foreign specialists in sanitation, education, agriculture, administration and military affairs have been put to work organizing a three-year program for interior development.

As proof of "reconciliation" with the United States, President Barclay selected three of these specialists in America. They are:

Maxwell Saben, administrative specialist, will deal with hinterland affairs. He has had wide experience with aborigine groups in Latin America.

Prof. Remington L. Embree, educator, has been made President of the College of West Africa here in Monrovia.

Capt. William D. Nabors, military specialist, had his training with the New Jersey national guard. He won credit as a officer of the Liberian frontier force under a previous administration.

The foreign specialists were selected in accordance with a plan suggested by the League of Nations. Liberia refused the League's active assistance on the ground that it would undermine the Republic's sovereignty, but welcomed the idea of bringing in foreign experts to carry out the vigorous reforms outlined by President Barclay.

One of the early acts of President Barclay after his inauguration was to open Liberia's first national exposition of agriculture and industry. The exposition grounds covered eleven acres on the outskirts of Monrovia.

More than 50,000 natives

from the interior, including 500 chiefs attended the fair grounds were turned over to them for tribal dances and on the last day the horse races.

The desire of man to worship that which is greater and more holy than himself, or to adore the invisible divinities or qualities of life did not find its origin in the systematic services conducted by Churches, Cathedrals or Synagogues.
