Nacional de Costa Rica, interesado en mejorar la economía del país, serán factores decisivos.

Las autoridades han dictado medidas para reducir en lo posible el consumo de gasolina, habiendo sido alterados los taxímetros y otros vehículos con el fin de que empleen gasolina comprimida.

300 MIL HOMBRES TIENE FINLANDIA EN EL SERVICIO DE LAS ARMAS

HELSINKI, 13. UP. — De fuente autorizada se ha sabido que Finlandia tiene en este momento un total de trescientos mil hombres en el servicio de las armas, número que prácticamente representa la fuerza total con sus reservas del ejército de la nación, pero se calcula que otros 150 mil hombres podrán ser movilizados, principalmente miembros de diferentes organizaciones voluntarias y hombres de 40 hasta 50 años de edad.

NOTAS EDITORIALES

VISIONES OPTIMISTAS

En un reportaje concedido al Diario de Costa Rica del viernes pasado, hace don Eladio Prado — Gerente de la Sucursal del Banco de Costa Rica en Limón — algunas observaciones sobre la situación que atraviesa la ciudad. A las preguntas que el reportero le formula sobre la crisis de la provincia, el señor Prado dice: "... si por acaso existe esa depreciación de que se me habla yo no me he dado cuenta de ella ni veo por qué podría haberla".

Muy optimista parece don Eladio en las apreciaciones que copiamos. Muy optimista porque la situación no puede ser mas angustiosa. Paralizada casi por completo la fuente que nos dió vida durante los últimos veinte años, el decaimiento general tiene que ser la consecuencia lógica. Hace apenas dos años la exportación de bananos llegaba a mas de trescientos mil racimos mensuales, que producía esta zona. El mes pasado apenas llegó a ciento cincuenta mil. El peligro de la sigatoca ha cancelado toda actividad en la resiembra. El promedio de vida de una finca de bananos apenas llega a cuatro años. Nos queda apenas dos años de vida. Si esto no es alarmante y no es desastroso, ignoramos que pudiera serlo mas.

La propia sucursal del Banco en esta ciudad ha trasladado a San José tres altos empleados que no han sido repuestos. Eso indica que su volumen de negocios ha disminuido mucho.

Tampoco afuera las cosas tienen el color sonrojado que les ve don Eladio. Recorra el señor Prado las calles de Limón y verá el sin número de casas vacías esperando inquilinos. Visite las tiendas y contemple la paralización casi completa de las tiendas. Pregunte a los médicos. Ellos le dirán el enorme desfile de enfermos que llegan a solicitar servicios y medicinas gratis. Algo parecido le dirán los otros profesionales que difícilmente pueden sostenerse actualmente. Pero no son estos detalles solamente los que indican la mala situación que atravesamos. Casi extinguidas las fincas de banano, no tenemos otro medio de vida que la producción de cacao. Esta, desgraciadamente, se abandona en los tiempos de bonanza y ahora su volumen no alcanza a mantener una situación ni siquiera mediana.

Desgraciadamente los que vienen del interior a recibir o dejar algún parente, visitan lógicamente nuestro balneario municipal, y piensan que el movimiento que tiene ese centro de diversión es el termómetro de nuestro bienestar.

Es cierto que allí van muchas gentes las noches del sábado y domingo. Pero esos concurrentes son casi en su totalidad empleados de la Compañía Bananera que ganan buenos sueldos en oro, marineros y turistas. Los que están afuera, contemplando los bailes y escuchando la orquesta son la masa general de la población que carece de dinero para entrar.

Estas cosas, dichas así, al correr de la pluma, son apenas un bosquejo de lo que aquí sucede, no obstante que nuestro estimado amigo el señor Prado y el Gobierno, piensan que la crisis no existe porque todavía no ha tocado a sus puertas con el toque lento, pero continuo y fatídico de las cosas que no tienen remedio.

Suprimida por economía la Agencia de Policía de Monte Verde, del Cantón de Siquirres

curules parlamentarias y edilicias.



THERE IS NEED FOR A LIBERAL EDUCATION

Education is a subject which seriously confronts us, and whether we appreciate it or not, we are faced with the fact that the cross-roads of our destiny has been reached and we are called upon to choose for the future. It behoves us to make a proper choice so that our children may not have to undergo the same unfortunate fate we have experienced. Regardless of depressing conditions, we should in no manner neglect this all important department of our lives. The average parents will proclaim their desire that their off-spring should be possessed of a perfectly sound education, but the large majority do not lend their aid to this being attained. — They exhibit what must be termed a mere sentimentality. All who would secure proper living would justly perform their tasks, and skilfully and magnanimously do what is required of them, must in this age be possessed of a liberal education. Living with our backs continually to the wall, is an exceedingly poor kind of existence. We need an education which will enable us to have a greater participation in the various sciences now almost in common use. If we desire to be numbered among the survivors of the fittest and be ready to scope with the changes and emergencies of an ever changing world, we must get in the van-guard of present — day requirements. Our education should be along modern lines — not a mere knowledge of such things as are already known and fully exploited. It is of course quite right that we know of these; we greatly regard their importance, their value, but much more is now being asked of us.

Scientific knowledge is ever on the increase, and history tells us that those who have manifested the greatest power in their days, have been the men and women whose education was not confined to that standard usually required for the eking out of a mere ordinary living. WIRELESS NEWS

MOSCOW. — Reports of a concentration of a Russian naval power in the gulf of Finland emphasized the vigor of the Soviet Union's drive to regain the dominant position she held in the Baltic Sea before the world war. Despatches from Kronstadt, the big naval base near Leningrad, said that a "whole armada of battleships" was massed there and that naval and military activities were increasing.

OSLO. — A German bombing plane which made a forced landing near Regeveng on the 10th. was so damaged as to lead to the belief it had been engaged in an air battle. A Norwegian coast Guard ship towed the wreck with the crew of four aboard to Egersund where they were held.

MEXICO. City. — An informed source states that transportation problems, brought on by the war, had caused the accumulation in Houston, Texas, of \$ 1,000,000.000 worth of petroleum products owned by the Mexican Government and consigned to Europe.

BERLIN. — Three men convicted of disclosing German State secrets to the Polish Intelligence Service were beheaded on the 11th. They were employees of the Polish State railway at Danzig.

ROME. — The newspaper Il Corriere Padano owned by the Air Marshal Italo Balbo, Governor of Libya, declared in an editorial that the Fascists were "born anti-communists and are determined to so remain." The editorial was interpreted as a rebuke to some Italian papers which printed favourable articles about Soviet Russia after the development of the new German-Russian partnership.

BUDAPEST. — Widely published dispatches said the German government had been conducting secret discussions for several weeks with Balkan States relative to transplanting Southeastern European Minorities to Germany. The dispatches said a plan had been advanced whereby Germany would pay expenses for transporting as many as 2,000,000 Germans now residing in Rumania, Yugoslavia and Hungary as might desire to settle what were Western Poland and Czechoslovakia.

BERLIN. — Fuehrer Hitler has listed the losses of Germany's armed forces in the Polish campaign as 10,572 killed, 30,322 wounded and 3,404 missing.

PEACE NOT YET IN SIGHT FOR EUROPE

Hitler's Peace proposals having been finally rejected, the war is to be fought until England and France have obtained the objectives for which they entered the conflict—the complete destruction of the Hitlerism Menace and the restoration of Czechoslovakia and Poland. This determination on the part of his opponents seem to be causing the Nazi Dictator an unusual amount

of worry, and rather significant suggestions are heard regarding the intervention of some one or other of the neutral nations on behalf of "Peace". Germany's old Ally, Italy, does not, however, seem in any way desirous of interfering, and it is known that the Soviet Union is playing her own game and so does not mind the war being prolonged.

OVER FIVE MILLION KILOS CACAO EXPORTED FROM JANUARY TO SEPTEMBER OF CURRENT YEAR

According to the information we have received in connection with our important Cacao Trade, we have it that the exports effected for the nine months of the present year have reached the very encouraging total of nearly five and a half million kilos, against an aggregate of four millions for the similar period of the past year.

As a result of the very satis-

factory prices at which the product has been sold abroad, we have already surpassed last year's intake by some three hundred thousand dollars. It is sincerely hoped that, with the interest being evinced by the National Bank, our planters will continue to be afforded steady sales with similar satisfactory results. They have long been suffering from poor markets and low prices.

AMERICAN NEUTRALITY ZONE NOT WAR THREAT

In one of his customary conferences with Press Representatives, President Roosevelt expressed the opinion that the Panama Agreement on the creation of a Western Hemisphere neutrality zone would not mean involving the United States in war in the event of hostilities occurring in the prescribed area.

The President further stated he was awaiting a report from the Naval Department, regarding the number of ships required for duty in the zone, to determine whether it will be necessary to commission additional old destroyers beyond those

already being placed in active service.

He also indicated that wider powers might be sought for the Export and Import Bank so as to facilitate greater trade with Latin America. He expected, he said, at the regular session of Congress in January to recommend that the \$ 100,000,000 already provided the Bank for trade expansion be increased substantially. He had originally recommended that the amount be 500 million dollars.

The Administration is endeavouring, it is known, to gain the markets opened to the United States as a consequence of the European war.

EATING OF EGGS CAUSE BLINDNESS

In a most interesting article in the "British Medical Journal," Dr. T. G. Wynne Parry, honorary Ophthalmic Surgeon of the Llandudno Hospital, relates the astonishing details of the case of a young woman who regained her sight after rapidly getting blind by the simple expedient of refraining from eating eggs.

During the year 1937 the young woman went to the ophthalmic department of the Llandudno and District Hospital for treatment to her eyes. She had extremely hazy vision, and cloudy deposits were discovered formed behind the cornea. As the defects persisted despite appropriate treatment and the surgeons could discover no reason for this, they sent her to one of the larger ophthalmic institutions. She was there placed on a treatment of prontosil — the basis of the wonder drug, M and B. 693. A patient under this treatment is forbidden to take any sulphur food, including eggs. Her condition improved almost immediately, and within a fortnight her eyes were practically normal. As there

was no apparent reason for this dramatic change, the young woman was closely questioned by a number of doctors who discovered that the cause of her cure was simply that she had stopped eating eggs. They found she was what is known as "allergic" to anything relating to the fowl.

If she lay on a feather mattress she was unable to sleep. If she ate the smallest quantity of chicken, she got violently ill. Her ailment was definitely decided upon when, sometime after the above treatment, her eyes were again affected. While breaking some eggs to mix into a cake, some of the "white" got on the back of her hand; she rubbed it off, but a few minutes later the skin began to itch and the mistiness of vision returned. She was taken to the hospital and as an experiment, a little white of an egg was rubbed into her arm. In two hours she could not open her eyes. The doctors have evolved a course of treatment whereby she will be completely desensitized of her very peculiar condition.



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AEROVIAS NACIONALES

ROLE OF THE FANATIC

In most of the terrible things that have happened and threatened in these times there is visible the workings of the fanatic mind, bitter as gall and narrow as the needle's eye. It does not matter what the fanaticism is—whether it is to glorify a nation, an economic class or a cause whose imagined end is shrouded in clouds. It does not matter—in each case there is a revolt against reason and reasonableness. The true fanatic goes forward unperturbed through tears and blood.

With foreign fanaticisms we can do nothing, except to guard against their effects here. With domestic fanaticisms we can do something—not by repression, which in itself reveals a kind of fanaticism, but by stimulating in our press, in public utterances, the spirit of reasonable men dealing with given situations calmly, in the light of evidence.

We have seen the integrity of our political life menaced within the past few years by what can only be described as verberations of the hysteria

Europe. Neither of our great parties, none of the factions within them, has been wholly innocent. We have had bitter attacks on personalities, in and out of office, in the economic field we have had recurrent waves of bitterness, in which what might have been treated as incidental differences have been allowed to harden into doctrine. We have been aware of a vicious undertow of racial and religious prejudice.

These phenomena are inevitable. They can be stimulated by propaganda, minimized by the calm and conscientious

tious spread of facts. For the private citizen there is a duty as a citizen. He need not listen to men who talk at the tops of their voices. He can guard himself against those who take unproved theories for granted. He can be wary of doctrines whose appeal is to the nerves or the spinal column rather than to the head.

If we learn well the lesson of this harassed and insecure generation we shall know that

in secular matters there is no one truth and no one light, but many truths and many lights. No one is so absolutely right that he is entitled to compel others to his views. The radical can learn from the conservative, the conservative from the radical.

There can be, in a democracy, a united front, not of belief but of agreement as to ways in which progress shall be attempted, rules by which the game shall be played.

European War Likely Increase Latin American Trade with U. S. A.

As the war moves on, American exporters already are looking toward Latin America. With the major industrial nations of Europe no longer able to compete with us, a greatly increased demand for American goods from the countries to the south appears imminent. Last year, according to the Department of Commerce, Germany sold \$ 238,000,000 of goods to Latin America, or 17 per cent of total Latin-American imports, and Great Britain and France together another \$ 219,000,000, or nearly 16 per cent more. These goods are now either no longer available or else available only in much curtailed quantities. Latin America will look largely to us to replace them. The United States, furthermore, is far better prepared than in 1914 to take advantage of the opportunity. Our merchant marine is much larger, our exporters far more experienced and our industrial plant much more developed than twenty-five years ago.

Nevertheless, we shall do well not to entertain extravagant hopes in this direction. Thanks to the steady develop-

ment of her own industries, Latin America is less dependent on foreign manufacturers than in 1914. More important, however, is the problem of payment. It may be that higher prices for her exports of raw materials and foodstuffs, together with the increased demand for certain of her raw materials as a result of further business revival here, will somewhat offset the curtailment of Latin-American exports to Europe and make possible larger purchases from the United States. But in general it remains true that Latin America can only buy more of our goods to the extent that we are prepared to accept more of hers—and the prospects for our taking more of hers are definitely limited.

It is for this reason that demands for export guarantees of various sorts by our Government should be watched with particular care. If there is no reasonable prospect for the repayment of the export credits, they are no better than outright subsidies. In this case they are simply a tax on the general public for the benefit of particular private interests. If subsidies are to be granted,

CAESARIAN OPERATION SAVES TWO-WEEKS OLD INFANT

A six-weeks old infant, located somewhere in Coventry, England, is reported to have been the cause of a world record in the art of Surgery. At the age of two weeks, a Caesarian operation was performed on her to remove another child, in a five months stage of pre-natal development. She has since been discharged from the Coventry and Warwickshire Hospital perfectly well and declared, in every sense, a normal baby.

Shortly after her birth she was observed to have an abnormally large abdomen, and her mother, on a Doctor's advice, took her to the Hospital. There the medical and surgical staff decided on an X-ray examination, which revealed the presence of the second child. The operation took place and on its

removal, the additional infant weighed two pounds.

A special set of instruments had to be manufactured for the operation which was watched by prominent members of the medical profession. The feat has aroused the greatest interest in all medical circles.

According to medical authorities, there have been a considerable number of cases of traces of embryo found in both external tumours and internally in the case of children; identifiable formations appear, however, to be of exceedingly rare occurrence. A search of medical records revealed only two similar cases in British Medical history. The more recent was in the year 1814. The specimens from these two cases are in the museum of the Royal College of Surgeons, London. (News of the World).

All these efforts have so far failed and the Allied forces are reported to be still gaining in their advance movements. Military circles announce the possibility of Hitler deciding to sacrifice no less than 500 thousand of his fighting men in a final frontal attack on the Maginot Line, fifty of more divisions having been concentrated in position for such an apparent purpose. The rumour is also again in circulation that the neutrality of Holland, Belgium or Switzerland might be disregarded in another effort to invade France.

Soviet Russia continues to be the upsetting factor in the general international affairs. After having completed her pacts of varying kinds with the other Baltic nations, she has called on Finland to cede her certain territory to further strengthen her position in this region. The demand will

it is said be rejected by the Finnish government, and as this will mean another war, the other Scandinavian nations as well as the United States of America are reported to be pressing Moscow to amicably settle the matter.

The negotiations between Turkey and England and France on the one hand, and Turkey and Russia on the other are still proceeding. Nothing definite however is being given out regarding the terms settled so far. Rumour has it that Russia is to be assured that the pact with England and France will in no way permit of the use of the Dardanelles and Black Sea by her enemies. It is also stated that the one to be concluded with Russia will prohibit belligerent activities against Germany by Turkey. The outcome is being anxiously awaited as on this will, it is firmly believed, depend Italy's final decision.

The result of the past week's activities have found Germany in a more difficult position than ever, so say well informed observers.

Claro está que la posición del comunismo tico ha resultado arlequinesca.

Cómo presumir, por otra parte, que los pipiolos que por acá se aparecen, sean capaces de una actuación elevada en problemas que están fuera del alcance de su microscópica concepción? Ellos, a ciegas, están conforme con elogiar y defender a Stalin; pero de ahí no pueden pasar, no tienen alas para volar más alto.

Mora y compañía están muy bien en el manejo de la poliquería tinterillesca de por acá; pero no se les exija que pongan su mano en problemas de envergadura, porque ellos están muy por encima de sus limitados alcances.

Se me permite un ligero examen de las actuales actividades del comunismo, siquiera sea ojo de pájaro?

El comunismo criollo ha disfrutado de un éxito relativamente bueno en dos de sus apariciones eleccionarias. Pero ese éxito, más aparente que real, no se ha debido al contingente comunista, ideológicamente basado entre nosotros.

Me refiero a las dos elecciones de medio período, las de 1934 y 1938. En la primera obtuvo el comunismo dos curules legislativas y una en la segunda, en ambos casos en la provincia de San José.

Ambos resultados correspondieron, no a la suma de adictos al comunismo, sino a la ausencia de partidos de oposición convenientemente constituidos. En 1934, además de eso, existió la tibieza de las gentes, indiferentes al sufragio, cuya abstención tuvo el efecto de que el coiciente electoral fuera bajísimo, circunstancia que favoreció al pequeño grupo de la hoz y el martillo acampado en la capital de la república, ya que de todos es sabido que en los distritos rurales esa semilla es totalmente desconocida.

En las dos ocasiones hubo, pues, una "inflación artificial

del comunismo. Por su papeleta, pero sin participar de su fealdad ideológica, votaron algunos costarricenses, a quienes no vacilo en tachar de inconscientes, guiados por el deseo de sufragar en contra del partido triunfante e insatisfechos de la papeleta opositora.

Pero no se trató en forma alguna de adeptos, ni siquiera de simpatizantes del comunismo.

Como concluyente demostración de lo expuesto, está el resultado de las elecciones de 1936. En ellas si participaron los comunistas con sus propias fuerzas, sin contingentes artificiales, pues habiendo como había dos partidos definidos dentro de nuestra organización política — corteísmo y bechismo — nadie contempló la necesidad de dar satisfacción a su inconformidad votando por el comunismo. Este partido pues votó solo. Con cuál resultado? Con el del más desairado de los ridículos.

La simiente nefasta, pues — a la vista está — no puede fructificar, ni siquiera vivir con holgura relativa en nuestro medio, porque tales ideologías no responden a ninguna necesidad política o social de los costarricenses.

Pero, si como ideología está fuera de tiesto, como maniobra electoral está dando juego lucidísimo, para algunos bastante jugoso.

Recuerdo que un amigo mío, a quien se preguntaba qué era el comunismo criollo, decía sencillamente: "Pues la unión de gentes que saben como gente que no saben na'". No puedo menos que sonreír al recuerdo de esta frase, cuando veo, como ahora, la activísima participación del comunismo en la llamada "Alianza Democrática".

Pero esto merece párrafo aparte.

Laverán, uno de los investigadores que se han distinguido en los trabajos relativos al paludismo

Fué el 6 de noviembre de 1880 que Carlos Luis Alfonso Laverán descubrió el parásito del paludismo en la sangre de un enfermo en Argel. Aquel descubrimiento de la causa de la terrible enfermedad que actualmente todavía afecta a más de 600 millones de personas cada año, fué acogida muy escépticamente al principio por los médicos coloniales. Pero Laverán estuvo acertado y sus trabajos marcaron el comienzo de nueva era en la lucha contra el paludismo. Veintisiete años después se le concedió el premio Nobel de medicina.

Cuando Laverán se encontró por primera vez "cara a cara" con el parásito del paludismo, no contaba más que treinta y cinco años de edad. El gran científico no debía morir sino a la edad de setenta y cinco años. En 1884 fué nombrado profesor en la Escuela del Val de Grace en París, de donde era oriundo.

No fué el premio Nobel lo que coronó la carrera de dicho desinteresado sabio francés, sino la gran satisfacción de saber que en su calidad de investigador en los trabajos relativos al paludismo, había iniciado nueva vía que permitía luchar contra dicha enfermedad. Su descubrimiento ha permitido en efecto determinar si un enfermo afecto de

fiebres es palúdico o no. Su obra científica abrió nuevos horizontes a los especialistas del paludismo. Cuando se descubrió igualmente en el mosquito del paludismo el parásito encontrado por Laverán, se tuvo la solución del problema relativo a dicha infección. El maravilloso producto natural constituido por la quinina puede administrarse más eficazmente a los palúdicos. Por otra parte, en estos últimos años, la Comisión del Paludismo de la Sociedad de las Naciones ha apoyado más seriamente los esfuerzos de los que luchan contra la malaria, gracias a la siguiente prescripción: tomar en concepto preventivo durante la temporada de las fiebres 400 miligramos de quinina cada día y para el tratamiento propiamente dicho una dosis diaria de 1 gramo a 1,30 gramos de quinina durante 5 a 7 días. En su memoria, publicada en 1938, la misma Comisión del Paludismo acentúa en la página 130 (edición francesa), el hecho de que entre los medicamentos antipalúdicos, la quinina ocupa todavía el primer puesto en la práctica corriente, a causa de su eficacia clínica y de lo insignificante de su toxicidad, así como del conocimiento muy propagado de su empleo y de su posología.
