NOTAS EDITORIALES

LA PESQUERIA EN NUESTRAS COSTAS

En nuestro número anterior publicamos el informe sobre los ingresos del Mercado Municipal. En las observaciones que hace el señor Administrador, atribuye el poco movimiento del pescado al mal tiempo reinante y a que se remite a San José una gran cantidad de este producto.

En parte tiene razón el funcionario municipal, pero el problema de la escasez de pescado en la ciudad de Limón tiene otro aspecto que estimamos de mayor importancia.

No es cierta la creencia generalizada de que en nuestra costa Atlántica, especialmente entre Río Banano y Matina el pescado es escaso. Lo hay como en todas las costas del Caribe y lo hay en abundancia. No está naturalmente al costado del muelle ni a la orilla del mar en la proporción que quisieramos. Pero a pocos millas puede conseguirse en cualquier cantidad y en todas las épocas del año. Lo que nos hace falta es el equipo necesario de lanchas, redes y carros. Aquí carecemos de todo esto. Unos cayucos inseguirios y unas redes pequeñas no pueden darnos la pesca milagrosa de la Biblia.

Por otra parte, como consecuencia de la tragedia del vapor San Pablo, se prohibió el movimiento de pequeñas lanchas durante la noche. Muy atinada fué la medida en los momentos de peligro, pero ella ha perjudicado la pesca de manera alarmante.

Como a los pescadores no se les permite salir al mar antes de las seis de la mañana, no es posible que regresen a tierra a tiempo de vender el pescado a la hora del consumo que es siempre en las mañanas. Una lancha de remos como las que aquí usamos necesita dos horas para llegar a los sitios en donde están las manchas. Necesita dos horas por lo menos para tender y recoger las redes y dos horas para regresar hasta el puerto. Se han gastado seis horas en la pesca. A las doce del día, que es la hora más temprana a que pudieran regresar resulta demasiado tarde para vender su mercadería y tienen que perder la mayor parte por falta de refrigeración adecuada. En estas condiciones no es posible que haya pescado en esta ciudad y mucho menos que pueda venderse a precios bajos.

Nosotros creamos que el peligro de submarinos o actos de sabotaje ha pasado casi completamente y que la prohibición de pesca durante la madrugada hace un perjuicio sin que reporte beneficio ninguno a la defensa continental.

Si se dieran en este aspecto todas las facilidades posibles a los pescadores sin perjuicio de mantener sobre ellos toda la vigilancia necesaria, controlando sus actividades, se olivaría muchísimo la situación de esas pobres gentes y ganaría la población con tener pescado fresco y barato, ahora que la carne resulta artículo de lujo.

NO TIENE RAZON EL INGENIERO VOLIO

En un informe que el ingeniero señor Claudio A. Volio envía a la Secretaría de Agricultura, y que le fue pedido a solicitud de nuestro cónsul en la República de Panamá, afirma que la zona Atlántica no es propia para ganadería.

La necesidad de mandar nuestro material periodístico a San José, con la debida anticipación, nos impide ocuparnos extensamente de ese informe.

La opinión particular que el señor Volio tenga sobre las condiciones de la ganadería en esta zona, no tiene otra importancia que el carácter oficial con que la viste. El perjuicio que esa opinión hace causar a la provincia va a ser incalculable. Nosotros la aceptaríamos resignados si ella estuviera cimentada sobre una base sólida. ¿Querría decirnos el señor Volio qué experiencia personal ha tenido? ¿Qué estadísticas ha consultado? ¿Qué promedio de gastos ha calculado para sentar una promesa tan radical como la que aparece en su informe?

El señor Volio, precisamente por su carácter oficial y sobre todo, por las consecuencias que ha de acarrear su in-

Sesión Décima Séptima Ordinaria de la Municipalidad de Limón, iniciada a las diecinueve y media horas del seis de julio de mil novecientos cuarenta y tres, con asistencia de los Regidores señores Campos, Presidente, Solé y Espinach. Estuvieron presentes los Jefes de Dependencias señores Aguirre, Arrázola, Barrantes, Casco, Martínez, Montero, Mora Aguilar, y Zeledón. Se excusó por enfermedad don Lucas Alvarado.

Artículo Primero.—Acta: Se leyó aprobó y firmó el acta de la sesión anterior.

Artículo Segundo.—Oficios del señor Gobernador: a) En nota N° 854 informa que como un correctivo disciplinario, el señor Jefe de Sanidad suspendió por quince y ocho días respectivamente a sus subalternos Manuel Vicente Martínez y Manuel Angel Martínez, habiéndose nombrado a Eduardo Calderón Cantillo para reemplazar a Manuel V. Martínez durante el término de la suspensión. Asimismo informa que por haber renunciado el ayudante del fontanero, señor Hilario Peña se nombró a Efraín Mejía para sustituirlo. Se acordó: Aprobar lo hecho por el señor Jefe de Sanidad y el señor Gobernador.

b) En nota N° 866 comunica que el señor Arturo Wo Ching, interesado en la creación de una patente de licorés en 26 Millas, ha depositado la suma necesaria para responder a los gastos que ocasiona el censo de la población mencionada; solicita se designe el delegado del municipio para esa diligencia y sugiere al señor Inspector de Rentas y Patentes Municipales. Se acordó: Nombrar al señor Inspector de Rentas y Patentes Municipales para que en representación del Municipio haga el censo de la población de 26 Millas para el efecto indicado.

THE UNITED NATIONS CONTROL

From the earlier days of the month in course we expected the receipt of news of a thrilling character regarding the activities of the United Nations on the several battle fronts. We had not long to wait.

Early last Saturday the news came across that invasion of the European continent had commenced with the landing on the important Italian island of Sicily of large numbers of British, North American and Canadian troops under the supreme command of General Eisenhower. We also had the report that the Russians had dominated the recently initiated Nazi offensive and inflicted tremendous losses on them. The Japanese were stated to have suffered further at the hands of the North Americans.

The invasion of Sicily was effected, we are told, after the way had been made clear by a ferocious aerial attack and the active bombardment of the coastal defences by Allied naval units. The brave deed is said to have been accomplished by

hed without the loss of even one of the two thousand vessels employed and with an unusually small number of casualties among the troops. Each advice which comes to us tells of rapid advances and added successes by the invading forces.

More than fifteen of the important cities in the Island have fallen in the hands of the Allied troops; and the latest advices state that the advance continues on all fronts, the movements being directed northward.

The important bases of Messina, in Sicily; and San Giovanni, in Italy, have been severely hit by air units with the view of hindering reinforcements reaching the Nazis on the Island where they are said to be experiencing difficulties in securing sufficient ammunition and other supplies.

The allied activities have reached such a stage in Sicily that a report states the Nazi forces are to be withdrawn for concentration along the Italian coast. A last moment report places the number of

PROVISIONS OF SOCIAL SECURITY LAW SHOULD BE APPLICABLE TO LIMON

Wherever domiciled, the worker deserves protection in every branch of service. At the close of his career, whether because of disability or imbecility, he should have some financial source on which he can depend other than the uncertain and unstable one of charity.

On an impartial review being made of existing conditions it will be clearly observed that whether privately or publicly employed, a very large percentage of our people are the recipients of remunerations hardly sufficient to provide their families and themselves with proper food and raiment.

Neither the worker nor the members of his family are immune from the ailments to which humanity is subjected, and when any of these set in the afflicted is usually without the means of procuring proper medical treatment apart from the limited amount he might obtain, if affiliated with some charitable or fraternal organization. However thrifty the worker may be, the possibility of his setting aside any reasonable sum as provision against the proverbial "Rainy Day" is very remote.

We are of the opinion that the Social Security Plan, as promulgated by His Excellency the President of the Republic, has within its sphere the most effective means of solving the difficulties, as it provided a guarantee by which the worker and his family will be able to obtain medical attention, hospitalization, share in a pension and receive other essential humanitarian benefits.

The operations of the Splendid System must eventually lift the economic, social and moral status of the worker and his family. We urge that this great Plan be placed in operation in this Zone.

PROFITEERS WILL BE PUNISHED

Due, we understand, to be repeated, the guilty party the initiative of the Nation will give the maximum Price Control Committee sentence and his license suspended until one year after been promulgated by the the close of the war. If the National Congress, destined offender happened to be a foreigner, he will be deported after having served his term of imprisonment.

The provisions of the law will be effective on Monday the 27th. of the current month.

THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE TAKING OF THE BASTILLE

On giving consideration to the French Revolution, which had its birth in the year 1789 and to the nation's fall in June 1940, we might be permitted to say that within the period of a little more than one hundred and fifty years the French people enjoyed that freedom which is usually associated with nationhood.



HITLER'S LATEST OFFENSIVE IN RUSSIA FAILS

After eleven days of the most violent fighting along the Orel - Kursk - Belgorod front, the Germans have again failed in their effort to dominate the Soviets. Their losses are given as 54,000 men, 3,608 tanks and 1,650 planes. The Russians have now assumed the offensive.

Hitler, who personally directed activities in the Kursk sector, has abandoned the position and gone back to Berlin for the purpose, it is supposed, to confer with his High Com-

mand regarding the difficult problems created with the failure of the offensive and the imminent Italian disaster.

So effective has been the Russian counter offensive, started last Tuesday, that more than one hundred districts have been recaptured and territory to the extent of twenty miles covered in the heart of the enemy defence zone. Over 12,000 prisoners have also been captured and much war materials.

BULLETINS FROM BRITAIN

FINEST AIRCRAFT, BIGGEST BOMBS TO MOUNT GREAT OFFENSIVE

The Royal Air Force to-day has been built up into the greatest single fighting air service in existence — a balanced Air Force capable of sure defence and shattering attack.

A year ago the Prime Minister announced that we had reached air parity with Germany. We have been drawing ahead of the enemy's production figures and steadily winning for ourselves a position of numerical air superiority in quality, right from the Battle of Britain days, the R. A. F. have always maintained a lead.

In September the output of weight of aircraft rose by 18 per cent over the August figures. That meant, as Mr. Herbert Morrison, Home Secretary, stated in his recent Cardiff speech, that nearly six tons of aircraft were produced in September for every five tons forthcoming in August. And the figures for both months were higher than any achieved since war began.

Fighter Command in Great Britain is now many times as powerful as it was in 1940. A thousand aircraft sorties were sent out over Dieppe, fighter sweeps 500 strong roar over France.

Fighter Command is in the van. Its equipment is still the world's best. By day the latest version of the Spitfire reigns supreme. By night the deadly Beaufighter not only waits for the enemy bombers but goes out and destroys them.

TREMENDOUS STRIKING FORCE

Bomber Command, has the most powerful striking force at its command that exists in the world to-day. Hundreds of great four-motor bombers, Stirlings, Halifaxes and Lancasters thunder from the coasts of England after dark bearing many tons of the world's biggest bombs to Germany.

Nor is this all. In the de Havilland Mosquito day bomber the RAF has the fastest bomber ever built and one of the fastest aeroplanes in the world in any category. Their speed, combined with long-range and a formidable bomb-load makes the Mosquito probably the most useful tactical aircraft ever built.

Operating from both sides of the Atlantic and from Iceland, Coastal Command of the R. A. F. is keeping a constant patrol over convoys the whole way across. Its toll of enemy submarines rises steadily. The air escort is the thing which U-boat commanders dread most. More than fifty million miles has been flown by Coastal Command since war began.

OVERSEA TRIUMPHS

Oversea the R. A. F. is no less active — in fact eighty per cent of total British armament production is sent out of this island these days.

HITLER'S CHINESE WALL

The Germans boast that their line of defense for the "impregnable" Fortress of Europe is now 125 miles longer than the Great Wall of China. If this propaganda could be accepted at its face value it would betray a curiously subdued mentality in the conquerors of the Maginot Line. Perhaps it helps to lift the flagging spirit of the German people. More probably it is intended to produce the same effect as the firecrackers set off by ancient Chinese armies to scare the enemy. Certainly the German General Staff can be counted upon to know that the only line of defense which can hope to halt an invasion is the line of German soldiers mustered to meet the shock.

No Chinese Wall illusion can save Germany. Too many nations in this war have succumbed to similar illusions. In large measure France fell because of her Maginot Line illusion. The Mannerheim Line illusion betrayed Finland. England realized the emptiness of her long-cherished Channel illusion when the Luftwaffe began dropping bombs on London. A fleet of German U-boats thoroughly smashed our own Atlantic Ocean illusion. The Germans themselves have lost some illusions since the Russians overran their invincible hedgehog positions and the British burned the Mareth Line in Tunisia. Any German general who stills places his faith in fortifications is ripe for retirement.

In all history no fortress has ever been stronger than its defending army. No army was able to defend the length of the Chinese Wall, one of the most stupendously useless structures ever erected. No army would be able to man a wall 125 miles longer provided it existed. It does not exist. The Germans have built a system of defenses along their exposed coasts, ingeniously disposed and linked to interior strong points. But it is not continuous except for the waters which the Allies control. It can be breached in many places and may be breached in many places at once.

Steel, concrete and fire are not pleasant to face and no doubt the loss of life among the invaders will be heavy. But they will have the initiative. They will decide where and under what conditions the Axis must fight. The only dependable defense the Axis will have is the German Army.

In India, in Ceylon and in dozens of outlying stations the world over the new and greatly expanded Royal Air Force is playing its part.

Since war began the Royal Air Force has shot down in combat more than ten thousand enemy aircraft, and damaged thousands more. The RAF has its tail up, the RAF is offensively minded. Side by side with its Allies it is sweeping forward on the long flight to victory. The task may still

THE ITALIANS IN YUGOSLAVIA

Some currency has been given to the opinion that there is a profound difference between the German and Italian varieties of fascism. In that Italian fascism is milder, even humane, less at variance with the general Christian culture of Europe. Differences there certainly are, but not this one.

The Germans are past-masters both as organising their own massacres, and at inciting others to do their dirty work for them. The Italians, on the other hand, are noted for their lack of system, which gives their attempts to denationalise the population in Yugoslavia an almost idiot quality of cruelty. Theirs is a cruelty of nervousness, rather than a calculated cruelty, like that of the Germans.

But it is cruelty just the same. They are not gentle rulers.

There is an additional agony for Yugoslavs, in the Italian oppression. The Italians are Catholics, endeavouring to crush whole Catholic districts — part of Slovenia, part of Croatia, Dalmatia.

For the devout Catholics of these districts, the senseless persecutions, reprisals, and bloody massacres of innocent persons, perpetrated by fellow Catholics, must mean the break-up of their entire spiritual world, and a shattering of their most closely held beliefs.

This summer, in a letter to the Papal Secretary, which in authenticated form has only just reached us, the Bishop of the Dalmatian Island of Krk, Monsignor Srebrenitch, solemnly protested in the name of Catholicism against the un-Christian acts of the Italian occupation authorities, and gave a long and disgusting list of acts of violence against innocent civilians.

The Italian authorities terrorise by wholesale internments, and then, for those who take to the forests to escape, vent their rage on the old people who remain. "Instead of seeking out those responsible in the forest... they turn against the innocent citizens left behind," writes the Bishop of Krk.

The Bishop of Krk, appealing to the Pope to intervene, states: "The German Nazis also commit such acts, but they profess pagan and materialistic ideas, whereas both the Italian people and army is accompanied everywhere by a large number of Catholic priests and military chaplains, and this is a most serious circumstance, which is persuading the desperate Croatian people that the Holy Father permits all the above and similar brutalities, and has neither the will nor the power to prevent or condemn them."

SIERRA LEONEANS AGAINST THE AXIS...

The R. A. F. has attracted recruits from all parts of the world, but few have been more enthusiastic in their work than the pilots from Sierra Leone. Among the first men from Sierra Leone to be accepted for flying duties in the Royal Air Force were Leading Aircraftmen Ben Davies and N. M. Johnson, both

counted upon to know that the of whom recently began their training in Britain. Cadet Davies was educated at Prince of Wales School at Freetown, and later became an apprentice to Government's Broadcasting Station. He travelled from his home in Freetown to become a Wireless Mechanic in the R. A. F. So skilled has he proved in his work that he has been recommended for an advanced course in the Service. After completing his Initial Training Wing successfully and after flying in actual combat duty, he was reclassified as "air bomber under training". His duties are to act as the pilot's assistant, bomb map-read and operate a gun.

These men from Sierra Leone have proved to be fine airmen. After going through extensive intelligence and medical tests, they enlisted as pilots under training. At different stages of their training, they were sent to Scotland, the Midlands and South East England.

BRITAIN PREPARES INVASION

In addition to the numerous landing barges used by the Allied armies in the invasion of Sicily, thousands of similar craft, many of a new and highly secret type, stand ready in United Kingdom ports facing the continent, awaiting their opportunity to effect a similar operation, but on much huger scale, at some other point. The troops with their full war equipment are concentrated in the neighborhood of their embarkation port, and recent manoeuvres in England have shown that the 35 men with their gear in each barge can be landed in nine seconds, whilst the tank-carrying craft require no longer period for unloading. The whole landing operation is protected by escorting ships, amongst which are battle-launches able to approach close inshore with a fire-power equal to that of a medium destroyer. Smoke-screens are cast to cover the troops whilst they gain their first bridge-heads on shore. These expeditionary forces are organised on the same plan as the commandos, the thousands of men concerned in the operations working together in compact groups. The barge-crews themselves are also trained to take part in the land-fighting, after their job of navigation has been completed.

The men who will put the Allied armies back on the beaches of the Continent are the Naval Commandos. They have been training for months at sea and shore to land their cargoes of armed men in a few seconds, on shores where any such attempt would have been deemed impossible two years ago.

They serve in landing craft ranging in size from lumbering tank carriers down to fine fast boats which will dart to shore like arrows to rush infantry into battle.

On a quayside in Britain seamen can be seen wearing the Combined Operations shoulder flash of eagle, anchor and tommy-gun, putting finishing touches to guns, oiling winches, and testing gear, and stokers adjusting their engines, like mechanics fussing over their cars before the start of a peace-time Grand Prix race.

Nearly all the officers in these craft belong to the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve. They feel they are founding a new branch of the service, which, when the war ends, they will be able to hand over to regular officers, with its own technique worked out. Beaching is a skilled art and must be learned. If it is not properly carried out, the ships will become mere stranded wrecks.

Many of these officers have already seen action, although not all in landing craft. Several have been in the light coastal forces which raid enemy convoys on the Dutch and Belgian coasts. Most of the ratings have volunteered for this service.
